The New York State Girls Players Golf Camp will provide quality instruction from two of Northeast New York's top PGA golf professionals. The campers will learn the benefits of having a quality short game, be introduced to proper full swing timing and motion, be made aware of basic rules and etiquette and gain a better understanding of how to manage their games on the golf course. Activities will include full swing and short game exercises, V1 video swing analysis, TOMI putting analysis, and 36 holes of monitored play.
