Junior Boy's Points Availability Breakdown

"The Race to the Williamson Cup"

There are 9 junior boy's tournaments that will count toward the junior and sub-junior "Player of the Year". The first 6 events will determine the roster for 2 different tournaments– The Williamson Cup (Thus "The Race to the Williamson Cup") and The Tri-Cities Tournament. The top 4 juniors in points will get an invitation to participate in this year's Williamson Cup, to be held in Pittsburgh on August 13, 14. The Tri-Cities event is a competition between Buffalo, Rochester and Syracuse, to be held in Rochester on August 24. The top 6 juniors and top 6 sub-juniors will be invited for this event. Points are earned as follows (pay careful attention to the exemptions):

International Junior Masters (Invitation only) – June 25-29, East Aurora CC

Qualifying for the Top 16 – 50 points plus 5 points per win
Second 16 – 30 points plus 5 points per win
Third 16 – 20 points plus 5 points per win
Fourth 16 – 10 points plus 5 points per win

NYSGA Junior Qualifier (open to all WNY juniors, juniors and boy's divisions) – July 2, Lancaster CC

Winner – 50 pts	5 th – 30 points	9 th – 10 points
2 nd – 45 points	6 th – 25 points	10 th – 5 points
3 rd – 40 points	7 th – 20 points	
4 th – 35 points	8 th – 15 points	

Erie County Amateur (open to all WNY juniors, one division, however sub-juniors will earn points versus other sub-juniors only if they choose to play) – July 7, 8, Grover Cleveland GC (county sponsored)

Winner – 70 pts	4 th – 30 points
2 nd – 50 points	5 th – 20 points
3 rd – 40 points	6 th – 10 points

***BDGA Boy's Match Play (juniors and sub-junior divisions) – July 9, 10, 11, Sheridan Golf Course**

Winner – 100 points, 2nd – 80 pts, Semifinalists – 60 pts, Quarterfinalists – 30 pts, Round of 16 – 10 pts

***BDGA Boy's Stroke Play (junior and sub-junior divisions) – July 16, 17 (Elma Meadows GC)**

Winner – 100 pts	5 th – 50 points	9 th – 10 points

NYSGA Junior Boy's Championship (points count vs other Buffalo players only) – July 24, 25, Seven Oaks CC

THE RACE TO THE WILLIAMSON CUP - AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE NYSGA CHAMPIONSHIP, THE TOP 4 JUNIORS IN THE POINT STANDINGS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE WILLIAMSON CUP ON AUGUST 13 & 14 IN PITTSBURGH, AND THE TOP 6 JUNIORS AND SUB-JUNIORS FOR THE TRI-CITIES TOURNAMENT TBA IN ROCHESTER.

BDGA Men's Individual (points count vs other BDGA juniors only) – August 16, 17, 18, Brookfield CC

Low Jr – 50 pts	5 th – 30 points	
2 nd – 45 points	6 th – 25 points	9 th – 10 points
3 rd – 40 points	7 th – 20 points	10 th – 5 points
4 th – 35 points	8 th – 15 points	

Williamson Cup – August 13, 14, Pittsburgh (top 4 boys on junior points list will be invited, must have participated in both BDGA events*)

Lowest Buffalo score – 100 points, 2nd – 80, 3rd – 60, 4th – 40

Tri-Cities Tournament – August 24, Rochester (top 6 juniors and 6 sub-juniors will be invited, must have participated in both BDGA events*)

Lowest Buffalo score – 100 points, 2nd – 80, 3rd – 60, 4th – 40, 5th – 20, 6th – 10

***EXEMPTION 1: FOR MISSING THE STROKE PLAY ONLY – If a player qualifies for the USGA Junior Championship (July 16-21), he is exempt from playing in the BDGA Stroke Play. Points will be earned as follows:**

Qualifying – 75 Points

Making the cut (round of 64) – 25 points plus 10 points for each match play victory.

***EXCEPTION 2: PARTICIPATION IN BOTH EVENTS – Participating in the Men's Individual Championship can be used in place of either the stroke play or match play events if a player cannot make one of those for the requirement to earn Player of the Year.**

BDGA Junior and Sub-Junior Boy's "2018 Player of the Year" will be awarded to the player with the most points earned at the completion of all 9 events.
